




More than 100 sheets of maps relevant to Southeast Asia geography, administration, archaeology, etc.

Almost 1,000 digital items from the John M. Echol collection, Cornell University


Over 300 dissertations and theses from overseas universities

- Hundreds of research papers from CKS Research fellows.



 Cambodian traditional music







PICK UP THE BOOKS


Go to the bookshelves to pick up the books


Or Ask the librarian for assistance!



- Request articles (Currently available for CKS fellows, affiliates, partners). For more information, contact the librarian


